
SUZY MURPHY – Harbour Island

Lyndsey Ingram is a contemporary art gallery in the heart of London's Mayfair, specialising in original prints and works on paper from the Second World War to the present. The gallery stages an exhibition program of three to four museum-quality shows per year, handling graphic work by prominent international artists such as David Hockney, Grayson Perry, Donald Judd, Ellsworth Kelly, Wayne Thiebaud and Andy Warhol.

Lyndsey Ingram also represents their own stable of contemporary artists including Miles Aldridge, Tom Hammick, Jane Hammond, Georgie Hopton, Suzy Murphy, Sarah Graham and Kelly Reemtsen.

The gallery participates in major international art fairs, including Frieze Masters, The Armory Show New York, Masterpiece London, Art Miami, Untitled San Francisco and the London Original Print Fair.
